

# Families ski free at Winter Park this season when they buy a new cabin at Rendezvous



**R**endezvous – the year-round master planned resort at Winter Park – has created entirely new variations of the traditional mountain cabin to appeal to a new generation of skiers and mountain vacationers; and has some of those ready to deliver now, in time for the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays.

Buy one of those cabins before New Year's, and Rendezvous will buy your family's lift passes at Winter Park/Mary Jane for the great season ahead.

"We're already seeing great snow, and some forecasters are predicting an even better-than-average winter for Colorado with the El Niño weather pattern arriving," says Dana Keller, Vice President of Sales for Koelbel and Company, Rendezvous' master developer. "We have some choice resort homes ready this month that could have your family here for that snow, and then enjoying all of the trails and mountain sports at Rendezvous during years to come."

Those new offerings include new BuckHorn luxury-paired cabins at Rendezvous – with the size and privacy of a single-family cabin, including a 1-car garage – priced from the low \$400s.

BuckHorn cabins are designed for millennial tastes: buyers who'll spend most their time on the trails or slopes, and want to keep costs within range. They'll have modern styling and are in easy walking/biking range of shops and taverns in downtown Winter Park. And like other new designs at Rendezvous, they offer state-of-the-art kitchens and energy features that older mountain homes lack.

Opening day at Winter Park Resort is currently set for Nov. 18 – but you can come up and preview those and other cabin designs at Rendezvous now, pick one out, and be settled in for what are traditionally the most memorable weekends of the season. The family ski-free offer applies, as well, if you choose a new cabin design that won't be ready until later in the year.

Rendezvous – situated beside the historic Cozens Ranch and Museum on Highway 40 a half mile beyond the town of Winter Park – is designed as a gathering place for families, surrounded by alpine attractions of the Fraser River Valley, 70 minutes west of Denver. Rendezvous residents have their own hiking/biking/snowshoe trails leading

into 500 miles of national forest trails beyond; plus a private trout pond with picnic facilities. In addition to their close access into shopping and dining in Winter Park, they get a free shuttle to their own, cozy Club Rendezvous beside the Zephyr Lift at Winter Park Resort.

Ski-free offer applies to any newly built BuckHorn, ProngHorn, ElkHorn, MooseHorn, or BigHorn cabin designs at Rendezvous. Buyers must close by

Dec. 31, 2015, on ready-to-deliver cabins; or be under contract by Dec. 31 on cabins beginning construction.

Rendezvous' Sales Center is at 77795 U.S. Hwy 40, Fraser. Take I-70 west past Idaho Springs to U.S. 40; head west on U.S. 40 28 miles to downtown Winter Park; and continue past town a half mile – watch on the right for the historic Cozens Ranch.
